

# Privacy Notice

The AC Owners' Club (ACOC) respects your privacy and will only use your data in the ways described in this notice. When using your information, we aim to be fair and transparent and to follow our obligations under UK data protection laws. Your information is used for administering club membership, events and activities.

The ACOC is the Data Controller for the purposes of GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018. The club contact for privacy and data is our Chairman.

## Collecting your information

We collect your information when you fill in your membership application or renewal forms and event entry forms. You can give us your information using paper or online forms. The information you give us may include your contact details (name, address, telephone number, email address), personal information identifiers (membership number, competition licence number) and other information (vehicle details).

## Using your information

We use your information when you first apply to become a member of the ACOC and then to administer and renew your club membership, provide you with member benefits and when you enter club events. For competitions, we may publish some of your information in the programme and the results, which are considered public domain information. Your information is used in these ways to fulfil our contract with you. Your ownership of a particular car (but no other personal details) will be recorded as a historical fact in the relevant model register. If you win a club trophy, your name (but no other personal details) will also be recorded as a historical fact.

We may ask you for emergency contact and next of kin details which we will only use in an emergency, which is use for a legitimate interest. You should let any contact and next of kin know that you have given this information to us.

## Sharing your information

We may share your information with Motorsport UK as required by its General Regulations for governing motor sport, with other MSA registered clubs and the Shelby American Automobile Club, with medical personnel and with any other organisation if we have to comply with a legal obligation. We may also share your information with service providers, for example event timekeepers.

## Our website

When you use our website, we may collect information about you, in particular your IP (Internet Protocol) address by using cookies. We use this information to improve your web experience. Cookies help us to recognise you when you return to the website and they may help you to log in securely to you web-based services.
